

**Bedwyn Footpaths Group walk – from The Square, Gt Bedwyn, 18<sup>th</sup> August, 11.00 am. 6 miles**

**Little Bedwyn, Monk's Lane & Chisbury**

The route of this month's walk was from one of our most recent leaflets, Walk No 5. It's a 6 mile circular route from the centre of Great Bedwyn to Little Bedwyn, then it heads along a bridleway over the hills from Little Bedwyn and drops down to the A4 road before heading back up another bridleway to Chisbury. There are two lovely peaceful country paths, a couple of sections along lanes, and it is necessary to briefly cross and re-cross the main A4 road.

The route has some steady long uphill sections and 5 stiles on the homeward bound section but the flight of steps over the railway can be avoided by taking the road bridge instead. Some isolated sections of this walk can become overgrown so keep yourself covered and protected from tick and horsefly bites if walking it in summer. There are 5 stiles – all on the homeward bound section. Livestock are in the vicinity so keep your dogs close.

19 walkers came along on this relatively long walk. The sun shone for us and we had a lovely refreshment stop under trees by the bridleway.
