

Bedwyn Footpaths Group walk – The Village Hall, Gt Bedwyn, Sunday 20th October, 11.00 am. 3.8 miles

Amended route – The Brails

Heavy rain of the previous weeks has left some paths completely sodden, muddy and slippery and forced a change of plan. We had hoped to walk up Webbs Gully but that route was so slippery that instead we chose a different route with firmer hard tracks through both Brails. Thankfully the rain stopped on the day. 19 walkers and a couple of dogs came along for this autumn walk and to enjoy the Brails with the trees just turning colour.

The incline up Coster's Hill is quite steep but most of the route is fairly level and along good tracks through the trees of Bedwyn & Wilton Brails, with a final section along the towpath. There's no stiles.
